



## Dwarf marathon on the dwarf path in Klosters

**Date** Thursday, July 29th 2010

**Time** 1 pm - 5 pm  
(Starting time until 4 pm)  
You can walk the path individually (no guidance).

**Age** Children up to 10 years  
(Of course parents are also very welcome to accompany the children. For children who can not read it is necessary to have an adult to read the questions.)

**Registration** not required

**Length of the path** approx. 1 - 2 km

**Duration** 2 - 3 hours

**Getting there** With the Rhaetian Railway to Klosters Platz  
Take bus no. 3 (Direction Doggiloch) from the train station Klosters Platz to the bus stop Brachweg.  
Just right there the dwarf path starts.

Departure train station:	12.42	13.47	15.05	16.05
Arrival Brachweg:	12.47	13.52	15.10	16.10

**Getting back** The finish of the dwarf marathon is on the Mälcheti, Aeuja.  
From there you have to walk to the Aeuja Post.  
Take bus no. 3 back to the train station Klosters Platz.

Departure Aeuja Post:	15.12	16.12	17.12
Arrival train station:	15.19	16.19	17.19

**How it works** Every child gets a form with questions, exercises, puzzles and explanations at the starting point of the dwarf path (Brachweg).

Now you can start off the dwarf path individually and solve all the exercises and quiz.

Signposts will guide you along the dwarf path and assistants of the dwarfs will explain you the different exercises.

At the dwarf house at the end of the path you can hand over the form and there is a little surprise for all participants.

Children younger than 6 years can also take the short cut at the Töbelibach and go from there to the Aeuja Post.

All the forms will be evaluated and the distribution of prizes will take place on Saturday, July 31st 2010 at 12.30 on the Alpinawiese at the Bahnhofplatz.
