

Important Information and Instructions

COVID Certificate:

Recovered - Vaccinated - Tested: One of these three must be presented when the race number is issued based on the Covid-19 certificate and an official ID. We recommend getting tested in your own place of residence shortly before your arrival and race day. The validity of the tests must be taken into account here (PCR 72 hr., Antigen 48 hr.).

If the certificate is missing or invalid, participation in the Swissalpine 2021 is not possible. The starting place will be cancelled and a refund of the entry fee is not possible. Transfer of registration to another person or to 2022 is not possible in accordance with the "Information and Instructions" rules. Excluded from rebooking to 2022 are participants from distant countries who are not allowed to leave or enter Switzerland due to Covid regulations.

As a result of this restriction and the competition regulations, the start number must be picked up personally. The most important information is continuously communicated on the homepage and to registered participants by email (please check the spam folder regularly). Various investigations are in progress. These include special measures that the canton of Graubünden has decreed on the basis of the epidemiological development.

Fundamental procedure for certificate control:

Before the start number is issued, the certificate is checked. After successful and valid control, an entry ribbon will be issued, which grants access to the starting number distribution, the start / finish area and the luggage depot for the entire duration of the event. This ribbon must be worn until departure.

Certificate App:

The best thing to do is to download the “COVID Certificate” app so that you can carry your certificate with you electronically, which is provided in paper form or as a PDF document with a QR code.

Spectators over 12 years of age:

In order to gain access to the finish area, spectators must also be able to show a valid certificate with an official ID. Spectators are only allowed to be at the finish line. They are not allowed to take part at the start.

General protective measures for participants and spectators:

- All participants, helpers and spectators commit themselves, in the interest of running and towards the entire population, to adhere to the protection concept in solidarity and with a high degree of personal responsibility and to consistently implement the necessary measures.
- Only those who are healthy and fully vaccinated, have recovered or tested negative, have no previous illnesses or disease / Covid-19 symptoms, may be present at the event. People at particular risk must observe the specific requirements of the Federal Office of Public Health.
- It is mandatory to wear a mask in all indoor areas (toilets, luggage depot, starting number distribution, etc.).
- The distance rule of 1.5m must be observed everywhere.

Start Card:

The start card will be emailed to registered participants with the promo code for the Swiss Runners Ticket in the next few days. After that, the shipment will take place on 14th and 21st July 2021. Please also check the spam folder. The Swiss Runners

Ticket must be printed out.

Start Number Issue:

Start numbers for the K23 will only be issued in Klosters in the gym of the school building. The school is located in the immediate vicinity of the Klosters Platz railway station. The start numbers for K68 / K43 / K10 are issued at the ice stadium in Davos (north side).

Please have the following ready at the entrance to the start number distribution:

- Covid certificate & official ID
- Start card (authorization to pick up the start number)

The start number must be picked up personally as a result of the Covid certificate control.

* Starting numbers for K23 are only available in Klosters Platz and must be picked up in good time (entrance from the train station).

Start & Race:

- There is one start per run. There are no starting blocks.
- Start K23 takes place at 09.40 am at Bahnhofplatz, Klosters Platz.
- During the race, the runners of the K68 cannot change to the K43.

Kids' Race

As a result of the Covid-19 pandemic, the kids' run cannot be carried out. The registered kids will be informed by email.

Refreshment posts:

The refreshment points are located at regular intervals of 6 to 10 km. The refreshment station on the Panoramatrail is now at Sartiv (Pt.2524). The Sertig Walserhuus post is newly in Sertig Dörfli. Participants have to cater for themselves between the posts. The watermelon is a pilot project and is therefore only offered on one run and at one post.

The offer was checked and adjusted in cooperation with nutritionist & top orienteerer Sarina Kyburz. Meal plan and timetable will soon be available online.

Cloakrooms & showers:

As a result of the pandemic, cloakrooms and showers are not offered.

Luggage depot:

We do not recommend leaving any valuables in your luggage. The luggage of the K23 can be handed in at the start in Klosters. This is transported to Davos and can be picked up again at the ice rink at the luggage depot after the run. The luggage must be labelled with a suitcase label with the start number, name and address. Luggage labels are available at the start number issue.

Shirt & Pin

The pins / badges as well as the finisher shirts K43 and K68 will be handed out at the finish. The event shirts for K23 / K10 (when registering for an additional charge of CHF 10.- for K10) and the gift for K10 will be handed out when the start number is issued. The shirts may not be tried on due to Covid-19. Due to Corona, a pin will be handed out at the finish instead of a medal.

Spectators / accompanying people:

Spectators, supervisors and relatives are advised to go out onto the track and avoid

crowds. Here too, keep your distance.
